Balancing grace with highly kinetic motion, he allows his dancers to utilize and showcase every ounce of their animal energy. dawsondancesf breaks down the barriers placed on classical ballet and brings to light the strength and beauty that artists possess within themselves, allowing them to explore their voices through choreography and vision. Through this process, artists transform themselves, audiences, and the world of dance that surrounds them. dawsondancesf made its premiere performance at CSSSA in 2007. Hamza Walker is the Director of LAXART, an independent nonprofit art space in Los Angeles. He previously served as the Director of Education and Associate Curator at the Renaissance Society at the University of Chicago, a non-collecting museum devoted to contemporary art. Recently, Walker was a juror for the Venice Biennale's prestigious Golden Lion award. He has curated the talks and programs at the first edition of Frieze Los Angeles and the work of Sol LeWitt, an exhibition of works made specifically for reproduction in magazines, journals, and books. Walker co-curated the Made in L.A. biennial at the Hammer Museum and recent exhibitions include A Painting Is A Painting Isn't A Painting (2015) at the Kadist Foundation,

Teen Paranormal Romance (2014) and Suicide Narcissus (2013) at the Renaissance Society. He has contributed reviews and art criticism to Parkett, and Artforum, and to numerous catalogue essays. He is the recipient of the 1999 Norton Curatorial Grant and the 2004 Walter Hopps Award for Curatorial Achievement. Required for Visual Arts students. Open to all students as space allows.
