Young Joon Kwak is an LA-based multidisciplinary artist whose work spans sculpture, performance, video, sound, and community-based collaborations. Kwak's work harnesses the [de-]formative capacities of materials and tactics of abstraction to expand ideas around bodily figuration and embodiment. Kwak has presented solo and collaborative exhibitions internationally at galleries and institutions including Arko Art Center in Seoul, Korean Cultural Center in LA, and Walter Phillips Gallery in Alberta. Kwak held residencies at Michigan State University and Los Angeles Contemporary Exhibitions and has been awarded the California Community Foundation Fellowship for Visual Artists, Korea Arts Foundation of America's Award for the Visual Arts, Rema Hort Mann Foundation's Emerging Artist Grant, and the Art Matters Grant. Kwak currently teaches at CalArts and has received an M.F.A. from USC, an M.A.P.H. from the University of Chicago, and a B.F.A. from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago. Fred has been in the film business for over twenty-five years, writing, directing, and producing motion pictures. He produced and directed the critically acclaimed musical Gospel. In 2012, Fred produced the first film to be made under the UK-Israeli co-production treaty, Zaytoun. The drama was selected to screen at the BFI London Film Festival, AFI Festival, and Toronto International Film Festival, where it was awarded the Runner-Up Audience Award. Ritzenberg currently serves as the Dean of the San Francisco Film School, where he imparts his extensive knowledge and guides the next generation of filmmakers. **Required for all Film students**.
