- Students must be back on campus by 8:00 pm Sunday evening.
- If you sign out for just a few hours on Saturday night, you must inform your RA when you return to campus.
- If you are attending the Sunday field trip, please return before 11:00 am on Sunday morning to pick up your boxed lunch and make your way to the buses in front of the dorms. (Students may not attend the field trip unless they ride on the CSSSA buses to the event. Please do not arrive at the event on your own.)
