Tommaso Frangini & Tommaso Santambrogio

Film students will have the opportunity to engage in a Q&A with these two filmmakers:

Tommaso Frangini is a young Italian director based in Los Angeles. He holds a Master in Film Directing from the California Institute of the Arts - CalArts. In 2016 he worked as personal assistant to director Andrea Pallaoro on the film "Hannah", with Charlotte Rampling, winner of the Volpi Cup for the best female performance at the Venice Film Festival. He then made two short films, "Ecate" (2017) and "The Plague" (2017), selected and awarded at numerous international film festivals. The second is inspired by Goethe's "Faust" and Alexander Sokurov's directing style. At CalArts, he made "Patient 1642" (2018) and "Memories of a stranger" (2019), inspired by Dostoevsky's Underground", as well as his latest short film is "Finis Terrae" (2020), world premiere at the International Critics' Week Sic@Sic of the 77th Venice Film Festival.

Tommaso Santambrogio is a Milanese director, writer, photographer, and video-artist. He lived and studied between Milan, Paris, Roma and La Havana and he worked with several international acclaimed directors. These directors include Lav Diaz, on whose latest film he recently worked in the Philippines, and Werner Herzog, under whose supervision he made a short film in Peru in 2018, with Pupi Avati . He is known for L'Ultimo Spegne la Luce (2021), Gli Oceani Sono i Veri Continenti (2019) and Escena Final (2019). Wiht Werner Herzog, under whose supervision he made a short film in Peru in 2018. He was the judge representing Italy for Le Giornate Degli Autori of the Venice Film festival in 2017, and he presented Los oceanos son los verdaderos continents in the Week Of Critics competition. His first feature film by him is currently in preparation.
